SCOPE



Let's Get Started!

The Scope is designed to help you see proper alignment of your body, eyes, and putter.

Step 1: Insert the tips of the yellow rod into the holes of both of Scope legs.



Tilt the top of the Scope leg toward the center of the rod. It will "pinch" the rod and stabilize the legs and the rod.

If the Scope rests on the rubber tips, the rod will be higher; if the legs rest on the rod it will be lower.



Step 2: Align the Scope system to your starting target line. For a breaking putt, your starting line will be at the highest point of the curve.

Step 3: Align your body, feet, shoulders and arms to the rod.



Step 4: Set the ball directly beneath the rod.

Step 5: Roll putts through the gate of the Scope Legs.

Alternate Use:

Set the Scope leg on the line of your putt, between you and the cup. Roll your putt through the Scope leg. It's like Rifle Training!
